The Putnam County Fair Board Livestock Committee hereby extends a cordial invitation to you to participate in the 2020 Putnam County Fair Auction starting July 16th at 5:00pm. On Thursday July 15th 1:00 pm – July 16th 1:00 pm the livestock will be available for online pre-bid auction. You will have an opportunity to bid on animals and set a maximum bid until the close of the pre-bid auction. At that point, the live auction will take place. The animals will enter the ring with the high bid from the pre-bid auction. This pre-bid auction will allow the bidder to set a max bid to be used on that animal during the live auction. The pre-bid auction will utilize an auto-extend, horse racing style closing so this time could be extended. Animals to be auctioned at this sale have been raised and shown by the youth of Putnam County. The participants work hard all year on their livestock projects to produce top quality animals.

How do I register to bid? Only registered bidders over the age of 18 can participate in The Wendt Group online auctions.

Go to <https://www.juniorfairauctions.com> and select the upcoming Putnam County Junior Fair Auction from the Upcoming Events section. To register, select the Login/Register tab on the left-hand side of the screen in the navigation bar OR the Register dropdown button displayed at the top right-hand side of every auction page. Register for a new account by entering your contact information, email address, desired password, etc. Once you submit the auction registration form, please follow the steps to validate your phone number, and complete your user profile to 100% complete. Please keep your user information (email address and password) in a secure place as you can use the same account login for all online auctions hosted by The Wendt Group.

For your convenience, the Putnam County Fair Board Livestock Committee will make arrangements to bid on and purchase animals for you in the event you are unable to participate in the auction. We will transport the animal you purchase to a local meat processor or local livestock market at your request. The options for handling will be as follows:

- Send to Butcher: Call's Meat Market (prior arrangement only), Patriot Meat Processing, Nelson's Meat Processing, and Joe Leadmon's Meat Shop
- Send to Market: Animals will be delivered to the Jackson County Regional Livestock Market and a check will be directly mailed to you.
- Return to Exhibitor: You may choose to allow the exhibitor to keep his/her animal.
- Buyer Pick-up: You may wish to pick the animal up at the Putnam County Fairgrounds at a scheduled date.
- Donate to a local food bank: If you wish to donate the livestock to a local food bank, you may do so by choosing a butcher and paying the processing fee.

All invoices past 30 days from the close of the sale will be assessed a 1.5% late fee per month. You will have the option to pay with check, cash or credit card. All other payments may be mailed to Putnam County Fair, PO Box 955 Eleanor, WV 25070.
